Greater Adelaide Regional Plan (GARP) – Discussion Paper Engagement Plan	Following the SPC Workshop on Risk Mitigation for Regional Planning, the Communications & Engagement team have scheduled a strategy day on 15 May to incorporate the Commission's feedback into the GARP Discussion Paper Engagement Plan.
Regional Planning Engagement Consultant 'megabrief'	We are now out to tender to engage a consultancy to support the PLUS Communications & Engagement team with the facilitation of the seven regional planning Draft Plans.
	The brief is requesting corporate communications, marketing, digital, graphic design, social media and engagement support from the successful candidate.
GARP Discussion Paper graphic design	The key design elements and photography for the Discussion Paper to be finalised mid-May.
Digital Hub	Work has begun on the PlanSA digital Hub to house all GARP related materials, including Discussion Paper. The format for the new hub will be similar to the site created for the Expert Panel.
	The branding established for the Discussion Paper will continue through the PlanSA digital hub. The existing content under Regional Plans to be updated as soon as possible to bridge until the hub is ready to be published.
	The hub will be an integral link for all Regional Planning information and updates.
Six Country Regional Plans	The Engagement Plans for each of the six country Regional Plans have been updated at the conclusion of Phase 1 engagement and will be presented to SPC in coming weeks.
