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### Greater Adelaide Regional Plan (GARP) & Country Regional Plans

	The Brand Proposition will develop a language to describe this important piece of work across all communications and digital assets, including:

	The Brand Proposition will be a touchpoint for the Commission and PLUS team members and will be an important tool to ensure all materials are on-message and brand.
	It will contain a Purpose, Mission, Values, Intentions and Key Messages.
	The draft Brand Proposition will be presented to the Commission on 16 March 2023.
Chair's Introductory Message	Steven Murphy has edited the draft Chair's introductory message for the Discussion Paper to reflect the Brand Proposition and make the introductory piece punchier and more succinct.
Digital Hub	In preparation for the launch and release of the GARP Discussion Paper, a digital hub will be created on the PlanSA Portal to house all information relating to the GARP.

Code Amendments	The C&E Team are currently involved in the delivery of communications and engagement activities for the following Code Amendments:
	<ul> <li>Miscellaneous Technical Enhancement – The engagement report is currently being finalised and is expected to go to the Minister for Planning, along with the final Code Amendment document this month. Key stakeholders and the broader community will be informed of the outcome following the Minister for Planning's decision.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Flooding Hazards Mapping Update (Stage 1 of the broader flood mapping project) – Public engagement commence on 22 February 2023 and will run for eight weeks.</li> </ul>
	Bushfire Hazards Overlay – Engagement dates TBC.
	<ul> <li>Design Standards – Driveway Crossovers – Engagement dates TBC.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Future Living – Engagement dates TBC.</li> </ul>
Concordia	The PlanSA Portal content providing high-level information regarding residential land releases and master planning for Concordia, Sellicks Beach, Dry Creek and Hackham, and the land supply dashboard and the new Infrastructure Planning and Development Unit is being finalised. This is in addition to the existing content regarding the land release announcement featured on the PlanSA Portal homepage.
	An engagement plan for developing the structure plan for the Concordia growth area is being prepared, focusing on gaining State and Local Government, service provider and landholder input on broad infrastructure needs and rough costs before broader engagement is undertaken as part of the Code Amendment process.
	Early engagement will include presenting at local council meetings to explain the planning process. These council meetings are open to the public; thus, a draft media release will be prepared, aligning with the timing and information provided to councils at the meetings.
Port Pirie Master Plan	A strategy to engage stakeholders and community regarding the draft Port Pirie Master Plan is being finalised by PLUS' consultant Jensen PLUS, including input from the C&E Team. Subject to approvals via the Port Pirie Task Force, community engagement is expected to begin in April 2023.
	The Master Plan project is a key action of the State Government's Port Pirie Task Force's plan to reduce blood and environmental lead levels and to plan for Port Pirie's future growth. The Department for Energy and Mining (DEM), as lead agency for the Task Force, is preparing to pro-actively engage the local community about actions being undertaken. In collaboration with PLUS, DEM is preparing a media release to share outcomes from stakeholder master planning workshops held late last year, the aims of the master planning process, and the next steps.

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Review of Community Engagement Charter	As part of the Commission's 2022-23 Work Plan, a five-year review of the Community Engagement Charter (the Charter) will be completed in 2023.
	A 'Scheme' required under section 45 of the <i>Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016</i> to support the Charter review was approved by the Minister for Planning in late 2022.
	Based on the approved Scheme, the C&E Team will develop an engagement plan and engagement will commence following Cabinet sign-off on the report from Expert Panel.
Bushfire Shelters	A communications toolkit to help councils raise community awareness about private bushfire shelter planning requirements is being finalised. The toolkit includes newsletter and social media content, a flyer and a fact sheet answering frequently asked questions. The council toolkit complements the existing PlanSA Portal content published in December 2022.
	The South Australia Country Fire Service is reluctant to promote private bushfire shelters as they see these as a last resort and no replacement for 'leaving early'. Therefore, communications emphasise that shelters "provide no guarantee they will save your life", and there is a stringent planning, development and approval process that is critical to follow.
Climate Change Brochure	PLUS is in the final stages of developing a climate change brochure that will showcase the broad spectrum of work the Commission and PLUS do that may not be clearly understood as work that benefits climate goals. The draft brochure is currently with a consultant for a final language check. The Department for Environment and Water has also signed-off on the content.
